

The Specialist Dementia Care Program (SDCP) provides individual care for people who are experiencing severe Behaviours and Psychological Symptoms of Dementia (BPSD). People who are unable to be adequately cared for at home, or by mainstream aged care services.

The program aims to stabilise and reduce behavioural symptoms, so the person can eventually move to a less intensive care setting.

To join this program a participant must have

- an assessment by the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) call 1800 200 422
- and a referral and an assessment from
 Dementia Support Australia call 1800 699 799

Our **SDCP** is held in **Waratah**, a newly refurbished cottage-like residence with nine bedrooms.

The decor is fresh, new, and the design is dementia friendly.

The **private bedrooms** are clustered around communal areas just like in a family home. The kitchen and dining areas are flanked by a lounge which leads to a secure garden.

While each room is furnished, it's a resident's private space. You are welcome to bring in special memorabilia to make it feel like home.

Enjoy access to **24-hour nursing care,** meals, laundry and secure gardens - a nice opportunity for a stroll outdoors.

The **SDCP team of clinical staff** have been specifically recruited and trained to deliver a **person-centred**, **multidisciplinary** approach.

This ensures residents have access to medical specialists for appropriate clinical care and to a range of allied health professionals.

With the use of **specialised care** to reduce behaviours and psychological symptoms of dementia, in a dedicated **dementia-friendly environment**, we aim to eventually transition SDCP residents into mainstream aged care services.

Potential residents and their families must agree to accept a place in mainstream aged care when the resident no longer needs our specialised program. This place may be at Glenview or elsewhere.
